Purchase Location: Struthers Library Theatre Box Office (in person).

Purchase Time: Tickets must be purchased at the door on the day of the performance.

Limit: Limit of four (4) tickets per SNAP card presented.

Availability: Subject to availability; we encourage early arrival.
